Isaiah 42: 13— The Lord advances like a warrior; He stirs up His zeal like a soldier. He shouts, He roars aloud, He prevails over His enemies.

Isaiah 40: 10-11—“See, the LORD GOD , comes with strength, and his power establishes his rule...He protects his flock like a shepherd; he gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them in the fold of his garment. He gently leads those that are nursing.”

Matthew 23: 37-39— “Jerusalem, Jerusalem...How often i wanted to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!” –

Luke 22: 17-21—Then He took a cup, and after giving thanks, He said, “Take this and share it among yourselves. 18 For I tell you, from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes.” 19 And He took bread, gave thanks, broke it, gave it to them, and said, “This is My body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me.”

20 In the same way, he also took the cup after supper and said, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is poured out for you. 21 But look, the hand of the one betraying Me is at the table with me
