1. Fulfill your _____.

Luke 2:17-18, 20—After seeing them, they reported the message they were told about this Child, ¹⁸ and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them... ²⁰ The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had seen and heard, which were just as they had been told.

2. Hold to God's _____.

Luke 2:26, 28-32—It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he saw the Lord's Messiah... ²⁸ Simeon took Him up in his arms, praised God, and said, ²⁹ Now, Master, You can dismiss your servant in peace, as You promised. ³⁰ For my eyes have seen Your salvation. ³¹ You have prepared it in the presence of all peoples — ³² a light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory to Your people Israel.

Hebrews 13:5—For He (Jesus) Himself has said, I will never leave you or abandon you.

3. Trust God's _____.

- He will provide the resources you need.

Matthew 2:1, 11—After Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of King Herod, wise men from the east arrived in Jerusalem, ... ¹¹ Entering the house, they saw the Child with Mary His mother, and falling to their knees, they worshiped Him. Then they opened their treasures and presented Him with gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

Matthew 2: 12-15, 19-20—And being warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their own country by another route. ¹³ After they were gone, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream, saying, “Get up! Take the Child and His mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you. For Herod is about to search for the Child to kill Him.” ¹⁴ So he got up, took the Child and His mother during the night, and escaped to Egypt. ¹⁵ He stayed there until Herod’s death, so that what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet might be fulfilled: “Out of Egypt I called My Son.”

¹⁹ After Herod died, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, ²⁰ saying, “Get up, take the Child and His mother, and go to the land of Israel, because those who intended to kill the Child are dead.”

Philippians 4:19—And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

4. Keep the right _____.

Luke 2:33-35—His father and mother were amazed at what was being said about him. ³⁴ Then Simeon blessed them and told his mother Mary, “Indeed, this child is destined to cause the fall and rise of many in Israel and to be a sign that will be opposed ³⁵ and a sword will pierce your own soul—that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed.”

Matthew 26:29—But I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father’s kingdom.”

1 Corinthians 11:23-26—For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: On the night when He was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took bread, ²⁴ and when He had given thanks, broke it, and said, “This is My Body, which is for You. Do this in remembrance of Me.” ²⁵ In the same way also He took the cup, after supper, and said, “This cup is the new covenant in My Blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.” ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes.
