In All Things – part 4

1 Corinthians 3:16—Don't you yourselves know that you are God's temple and that the Spirit of God lives in you?

1. We are accountable for

1 Corinthians 1:11-12—For it has been reported to me about you, my brothers and sisters, by members of Chloe's people, that there is rivalry among you. ¹²What I am saying is this: One of you says, "I belong to Paul," or "I belong to Apollos," or "I belong to Cephas," or "I belong to Christ."

1 Corinthians 3:1-4—For my part, brothers and sisters, I was not able to speak to you as spiritual people but as people of the flesh, as babies in Christ. ²I gave you milk to drink, not solid food, since you were not yet ready for it. In fact, you are still not ready, ³because you are still worldly. For since there is envy and strife among you, are you not worldly and behaving like mere humans? ⁴For whenever someone says, "I belong to Paul," and another, "I belong to Apollos," are you not acting like mere humans?

1 Corinthians 3:5-9—What then is Apollos? What is Paul? They are servants through whom you believed, and each has the role the Lord has given. ⁶ I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. ⁷ So, then, neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. ⁸ Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his own reward according to his own labor. ⁹ For we are God’s coworkers. You are God’s field, God’s building.

1 Corinthians 3:10-11—According to God’s grace that was given to me, I have laid a foundation as a skilled master builder, and another builds on it. But each one is to be careful how he builds on it. ¹¹ For no one can lay any foundation other than what has been laid down. That foundation is Jesus Christ.
