Matthew 22:37-39—Jesus said, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. ³⁸ This is the greatest and most important command. ³⁹ The second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.

1. Love _____ first and foremost.

1 John 4:8—The one who does not love does not know God, because God is love.

Isaiah 58:11—The Lord will always lead you, satisfy you in a parched land, and strengthen your bones. You will be like a watered garden and like a spring whose water never runs dry.

1 Corinthians 7:1-3—Now in response to the matters you wrote about: “It is good for a man not to have sexual relations with a woman.” ² But because sexual immorality is so common, each man should have sexual relations with his own wife, and each woman should have sexual relations with her own husband. ³ A husband should fulfill his marital duty to his wife, and likewise a wife to her husband.

Ephesians 5: 22-26, 31, 33—Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord, ²³ because the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of the body. ²⁴ Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives are to submit to their husbands in everything. ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself for her... ³¹ For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh... ³³ To sum up, each one of you is to love his wife as himself, and the wife is to respect her husband.
