### ARE YOU SCARED OF THE GHOST?

Movies and TV shows have conditioned us to be fearful of ghosts. Spirits in the house are considered a negative thing. Look at what the Word tells us about the spirit world.

**Ephesians 6:12** —For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.

**Colossians 1:16** —For by Him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through Him and for Him.

**What do these verses tell us about the spirit world around us?**

So whether we choose to be aware of it or not, there are spirits that are out to trap us and get us off track.

The thing that many Christians fear the most is that the Holy Spirit will call upon them to do something out of their comfort zone.

**What would be something you would consider to be out of your “comfort zone?”**

**1 John 4: 1-3**—Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see if they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. 2 This is how you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, 3 but every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming; even now it is already in the world.

**According to John's letter, what should we must we do?**

**How can we tell which ones are of God?**

**How can we tell which ones are not of God?**

**Acts 2: 12-15**—They were all astounded and perplexed, saying to one another, “What does this mean?” 13 But some sneered and said, “They’re drunk on new wine.” 14 Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and proclaimed to them, “Fellow Jews and all you residents of Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and pay attention to my words. 15 For these people are not drunk, as you suppose, since it’s only nine in the morning.

**Acts 2: 38**—Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, each of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

**After Peter received the Holy Spirit, what did he do?**

Peter was always naturally outspoken. Where he was usually speaking on his own behalf, now, with the help of the Holy Spirit, he spoke out professing Jesus and supporting others who were speaking with the help of the Spirit of Truth.
