
FAMILY DEDICATION

PART VI: THE POWER OF CONSISTENCY

1. God-honoring character is developed through _____ in your devotion to Christ.

Daniel 5:22-23 CSB—But you his successor, Belshazzar, have not humbled your heart, even though you knew all this. Instead, you have exalted yourself against the Lord of the heavens. The vessels from his house were brought to you, and as you and your nobles, wives, and concubines drank wine from them, you praised the gods made of silver and gold, bronze, iron, wood, and stone, which do not see or hear or understand. But you have not glorified the God who holds your life-breath in his hand and who controls the whole course of your life.

2. Consistent faith requires _____.

Daniel 6:3,5—Daniel distinguished himself above the administrators and satraps because he had an extraordinary spirit, so the king planned to set him over the whole realm. Then these men said, “We will never find any charge against this Daniel unless we find something against him concerning the law of his God.”

Daniel 6:10—When Daniel learned that the document had been signed, he went into his house. The windows in its upstairs room opened toward Jerusalem, and three times a day he got down on his knees, prayed, and gave thanks to his God, just as he had done before.

Daniel 6:21-22—Then Daniel spoke with the king: “May the king live forever. My God sent his angel and shut the lions’ mouths, and they haven’t harmed me, for I was found innocent before him. And also before you, Your Majesty, I have not done harm.

3. The _____ is influenced over time when your faith is consistent.

Daniel 6:26-28—I issue a decree that in all my royal dominion, people must tremble in fear before the God of Daniel: For he is the living God, and he endures forever; his kingdom will never be destroyed, and his dominion has no end. He rescues and delivers; he performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth, for he has rescued Daniel from the power of the lions.” So Daniel prospered during the reign of Darius and the reign of Cyrus the Persian.

1 Peter 1:3-4—Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Because of his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead and into an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you.
