Leviticus 23:9-11 ESV—And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, When you come into the land that I give you and reap its harvest, you shall bring the sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest, and he shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, so that you may be accepted. But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.
