**Leviticus 23:26-28 CSB**—The LORD again spoke to Moses "The tenth day of this seventh month is the Day of Atonement. You are to hold a sacred assembly and practice self-denial; you are to present a food offering to the LORD. On this particular day you are not to do any work, for it is a Day of Atonement to make atonement for yourselves before the LORD your God.

1. Jesus did for you what you could not do for yourself so that you could receive what

you could never earn -

**Hebrews 9:11-12**—But Christ has appeared as a high priest of the good things that have come. In the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands (that is, not of this creation), he entered the most holy place once for all time, not by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.

**Hebrews 9:15**—Therefore, he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called might receive the promise of the eternal inheritance, because a death has taken place for redemption from the transgressions committed under the first

covenant. (see also, vs. 24-28; Hebrews 10:14)

2. Your worth is found in the Jesus for you.

Not in the opinions of others and not in your ability to be perfect.

3. God is not looking for perfection; He is looking for .

**Galatians 3:3**—Are you so foolish? After beginning by the Spirit, are you now finishing by the flesh?

**1 Corinthians 15:10**—But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace toward me was not in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them, yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me.

THE BIG TAKEAWAY:

in Christ alone is your \_\_\_\_\_ of God

accepting you.

**Matthew 27:50-51**—But Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and gave up his spirit. Suddenly, the curtain of the sanctuary was torn in two from top to bottom, the earth quaked, and the rocks were split.

**2 Corinthians 5:21**—He made the one who did not know sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
