Leviticus 23:23-25 CSB—The Lord spoke to Moses: “Tell the Israelites: In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you are to have a day of complete rest, commemoration, and trumpet blasts — a sacred assembly. You must not do any daily work, but you must present a food offering to the Lord.”

Feast of Trumpets began a 10-day observation called *Yamin Noraim* (Day of Awe!)

Three Vital Disciplines to Live in Daily Victory!

Psalms 139:23-24—Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my concerns. See if there is any offensive way in me; lead me in the everlasting way.

Psalms 63:6-7—When I think of you as I lie on my bed, I meditate on you during the night watches because you are my helper; I will rejoice in the shadow of your wings.

James 4:7-8—Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

1 John 1:9—If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 22:37-39—He said to him, “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and most important command. The second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.

When we truly confess our sin to the Lord, we are forgiven, but that is also true with one another.

James 5:16—Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is very powerful in its effect.
