Read Hebrews 12:10-13

3.) How should we deal with people who've hurt our heart?

When others hurt us it can be difficult to deal with, but feeling hurt by God is undoubtedly worse. God can feel so mysterious and far away that we feel we can't work it out. Things will happen, and not every little thing is a test from God. Simply put, we live in a broken world.
