FAMILY NIGHT @ THE DRIVE-IN

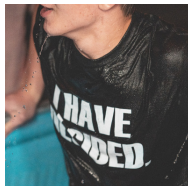

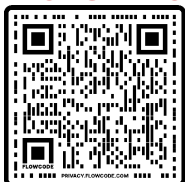
