Luke 10:30-35 CSB— Jesus took up the question and said, “A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho and fell into the hands of robbers. They stripped him, beat him up, and fled, leaving him half dead. A priest happened to be going down that road. When he saw him, he passed by on the other side. In the same way, a Levite, when he arrived at the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. But a Samaritan on his journey came up to him, and when he saw the man, he had compassion. He went over to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on olive oil and wine. Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. The next day he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said, ‘Take care of him. When I come back I’ll reimburse you for whatever extra you spend.’

Ephesians 5:15-17—Pay careful attention, then, to how you walk—not as unwise people but as wise—making the most of the time, , because the days are evil. So don’t be foolish, but understand what the Lord’s will is.

Hebrews 13:2—Don’t neglect to show hospitality, for by doing this some have welcomed angels as guests without knowing it.

1 Peter 4:10—Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God.

3. We steward our _____.

Mark 12:41-44—Sitting across from the temple treasury, he watched how the crowd dropped money into the treasury. Many rich people were putting in large sums. Then a poor widow came and dropped in two tiny coins worth very little. Summoning his disciples, he said to them, “Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. For they all gave out of their surplus, but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had—all she had to live on.”
