LEAN ON GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY WHILE WE ARE LIVING IN THE WAITING.

1. God sees you _____ you see your _____

Acts 7:20-22 CSB—At this time Moses was born, and he was beautiful in God's sight. He was cared for in his father's home for three months. When he was put outside, Pharaoh's daughter adopted and raised him as her own son. So Moses was educated in all the wisdom of the Egyptians and was powerful in his speech and actions.

2. God uses ______ to shape what He intends to ______

Acts 7:23-29 CSB-"When he was forty years old, he decided to visit his own people, the Israelites. When he saw one of them being mistreated, he came to his rescue and avenged the oppressed man by striking down the Egyptian. He assumed his people would understand that God would give them deliverance through him, but they did not understand. The next day he showed up while they were fighting and tried to reconcile them peacefully, saying, 'Men, you are brothers. Why are you mistreating each other?' "But the one who was mistreating his neighbor pushed Moses aside, saying: Who appointed you a ruler and a judge over us? Do you want to kill me, the same way you killed the Egyptian vesterday? "When he heard this, Moses fled and became an exile in the land of Midian.

Galatians 5:16-I say, then, walk by the Spirit and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh.
