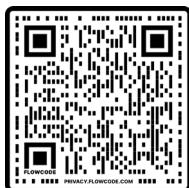

DEVELOPMENT IN THE DARK INCLUDES 2 IMPORTANT PHASES.

1. The Gershon Phase: When you feel _____, God is building your _____.

Exodus 18: 2-4 CSB—Now Jethro, Moses's father-in-law, had taken in Zipporah, Moses's wife, after he had sent her back, along with her two sons, one of whom was named Gershom (because Moses had said, "I have been a resident alien in a foreign land") and the other Eliezer (because he had said, "The God of my father was my helper and rescued me from Pharaoh's sword").
