1. Grace acknowledges the \_\_\_\_\_.

**Romans 7:18-20 CSB**—So now I am no longer the one doing it, but it is sin living in me. For I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my flesh. For the desire to do what is good is with me, but there is no ability to do it. For I do not do the good that I want to do, but I practice the evil that I do not want to do. Now if I do what I do not want, I am no longer the one that does it, but it is the sin that lives in me.

**Romans 7:24-25**—What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord!

**Romans 6:1-2**—What should we say then? Should we continue in sin so that grace may multiply? Absolutely not! How can we who died to sin still live in it?

2. Grace offers us a \_\_\_\_\_.

**Romans 6:3-4**—Or are you unaware that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? Therefore we were buried with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in newness of life.

3. Grace empowers us to \_\_\_\_\_.

**Romans 6:13-14**—And do not offer any parts of it to sin as weapons for unrighteousness. But as those who are alive from the dead, offer yourselves to God, and all the parts of yourselves to God as weapons for righteousness. For sin will not rule over you, because you are not under the law but under grace.

### **THE BIG TAKEAWAY:**

We become what we consistently say \_\_\_\_\_ to.

**Romans 6:15-16**—What then? Should we sin because we are not under the law but under grace? Absolutely not! Don't you know that if you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of that one you obey — either of sin leading to death or of obedience leading to righteousness?
