1. Be _____—the war can be exhausting.

Galatians 5:17 CSB—For the flesh desires what is against the Spirit, and the Spirit desires what is against the flesh; these are opposed to each other, so that you don't do what you want.

Galatians 5:22-23—But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. The law is not against such things.

2. Be _____—the war can be won.

Galatians 5:16—I say, then, walk by the Spirit and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh.

- b. _____ in God's Word—Psalm 119:11
- c. _____ in God's presence—Psalm 46:10

3. Be _____—victory requires daily surrender.

Galatians 5:24-25—Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.

Galatians 2:20—I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
