BAPTISM SUNDAY

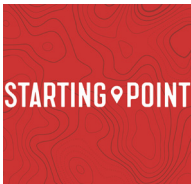
Baptism is an outward expression of the inward change Jesus brings. It's not too late to sign up, head to the Baptism Table by the **Big Red Wall** to register!

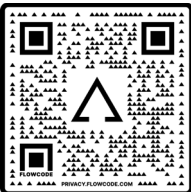

1 Thessalonians 4:15-18 CSB—For we say this to you by a word from the Lord: We who are still alive at the Lord's coming will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the archangel's voice, and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are still alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord.
